A board-certified ambulatory care pharmacist at Boston Medical Center, Courtney divides her time between primary care and high-risk obstetrics, focusing on managing diabetes and preventing complications among some of New England's most vulnerable patient populations. Her work bridges critical gaps in care, ensuring patients receive the specialized attention they need during pivotal stages of their lives.

Courtney's contributions to high-risk obstetrics have been especially groundbreaking. As the first pharmacy specialist to join her hospital's high-risk OB team, she not only filled an important role—she reshaped it. She developed a collaborative drug therapy management agreement specifically for pregnant and postpartum patients with diabetes, creating a structured, patient-centered approach to complex care. Her willingness to adapt her services—offering both in-person and telemedicine visits — ensured that patients could access expert support regardless of their circumstances.

Her influence extends beyond diabetes management. Courtney played an instrumental role

in launching a new clinical model for postpartum hypertension care, expanding her reach into another critical aspect of maternal health. This multidisciplinary approach reflects her commitment to addressing interconnected health needs and improving outcomes for underserved communities.

In addition to her clinical achievements, Courtney is deeply invested in mentoring the next generation of health professionals. She regularly precepts learners at every stage of training, instilling in them a strong foundation of patient-centered care and collaborative practice.

Courtney's leadership is also evident in her service to ADCES. She holds active roles in both the Pharmacy Community of Interest and the Massachusetts Coordinating Body, helping shape organizational priorities and share innovative practices with peers nationwide.

In a relatively short time, Courtney has established herself as a clinician, educator, and advocate whose influence is already being felt well beyond her clinic walls.
