She's played a key role in developing and managing her clinic's recognized DSMES program, ensuring that participants receive the highest standard of care. And her commitment goes far beyond the clinic walls. For many years, Mitzi organized an annual "Diabetes 101" day—bringing together people with diabetes to learn, connect, and feel supported in a relaxed, welcoming environment.

The Awards Committee was especially inspired by Mitzi's passion for mentoring others and making DSMES accessible to everyone in her region. Whether she's working with patients, guiding colleagues, or championing new technologies, she leads with heart, purpose, and a deep belief in the power of education to change lives.
